Sudafed Congestion Relief 0.1% Nasal Spray (Xylometazoline Hydrochloride 1 mg /1ml) Product Information

Presentation:

Nasal Spray Solution.

Uses:

For the symptomatic relief of nasal congestion associated with the common cold, influenza, sinusitis, allergic and non-allergic rhinitis, and other upper respiratory tract allergies.

Dosage:

Adults and children 12 years and over: One spray to be expressed into each nostril 2-3 times daily, as necessary. Maximum daily dose: 3 sprays in 24 hours. This product is not recommended for children under 12 years of age.

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to Xylometazoline Hydrochloride, individuals who are taking or have taken monoamine oxidase inhibitors within the preceding two weeks and individuals with hypophysectomy or surgery exposing dura mater.

Precautions:

Use with caution in patients suffering coronary artery disease, hypertension, hyperthyroidism or diabetes mellitus. Prolonged treatment may lead to reactive hyperemia of the nasal mucosa, patients with long QT syndrome.

Pregnancy and Lactation:

Consult doctor before use.

Side effects:

Not Known: burning sensation mucosal, nasal discomfort, nasal dryness, nasal pruritus, rhinalgia, sneezing, rebound congestion. Uncommon: Epistaxis. Rare: nausea and headache.
